Romans 6:10A - "When Jesus Died to Sin's Power, Once for All"

Jesus' substitutionary death not the whole truth about the cross

(1) what does it mean - Jesus died to sin?

Sin as master power - 6:15-23 ✓

Jesus' in-carnation, 8:3 ✓

Over Harrison

Sin as a realm; Jesus left it behind in dying

Galatians 1:4 ✓

(2) How is this true for us?

V11 - "reckon yourselves as dead to sin in Christ Jesus"

Believe that it is true, 3:28 ✓

How can it be so?

We died with Christ - verses 4-8 ✓

language used

⇒ Participants not just observers of Jesus' death

↳ Relationship to sin radically changed, verse 6

*"once for all" = 8!
FM - 2 of his times*

Christian baptism signs + seals our share in Christ's death, verses 3-4
